- 2. Duly completed visa application form (in duplicate in case of multiple journey visas). The form is appended here below
- 3. Two passport size pictures (full face showing both ears). Computer generated pictures are unacceptable.
 - √ \$50.00 for Single Entry (Tourist/Business) Visa
 - ✓ \$20.00 for Transit Visa
 - ✓ \$100.00 MULTIPLE ENTRY VISA with six months validity INTO KENYA
- 4. Cash and Personal Checks are not acceptable Cashiers Check or Money Order only. (payable to Kenya Embassy)
- 5. **Certified** self addressed stamped envelope for the return of your passport(s) i.e. Express Mail, Certified Mail or Priority Mail with delivery confirmation.
- 6. The envelope should have sufficient return postage.
- 7. Any application not meeting the above requirements will be considered INCOMPLETE and will not be acted upon.

PLEASE NOTE

- A visa is required prior to entry into Kenya.
- Visas are usually issued valid for six months from the date of issue.
- Visas are issued within 10 working days from date of application and 12-16 working days during the peak season of May - August.
- Determination of delivery of mail to the Embassy should be done through the tracking system of the relevant mailing service used and not by telephone.
- Applicants must allow for the ten days to elapse from the date the application was received at the Embassy before they can follow up on their individual cases.
- No Visa is required for direct transit passengers i.e those passengers not leaving the airport.

 Telephone queries must be made by the <u>applicant only</u>. Third party queries will not be entertained.

VACCINATION CERTIFICATE

- a) There are no mandatory immunizations required for US residents wishing to visit Kenya. However, immunization against typhoid, yellow fever and cholera are recommended.
- b) Anti- Malaria Pills should be taken particularly if the visitors will be traveling to the Western and Coastal regions of Kenya.

- 6. A certified self addressed stamped envelope for the return of your passport(s) i.e. Express Mail, Certified Mail or Priority Mail with delivery confirmation.
- 7. The envelope should have sufficient return postage.
- 8. Any application not meeting the above requirements will be considered INCOMPLETE and will remain unprocessed.

PLEASE NOTE

- A visa is required prior to entry into Kenya.
- Visa applications for **REFUGEE Travel Document Holders** are received at the Embassy and forwarded to Department of Immigration Headquarters in Nairobi for processing.
- The processing period takes approximately three months.
- Determination of delivery of mail to the Embassy should be done through the tracking system of the relevant mailing service used and not by telephone.
- Applicants must allow for the three months to elapse from the date the application was received at the Embassy before they can follow up on their individual cases.
- Telephone queries must be made by the <u>applicant only</u>. Third party queries will not be entertained.
- There is no expedited service for visa applications for Travel Document holders.
- A single journey visa is usually issued valid for six months from the date of issue.
- Requests for multiple journey visas must be applied for, in person, at the Department of Immigration Headquarters in Nairobi.
